We also request that you indicate whether you wish to 'Skip' a Rink when submitting your entry. All entries will then be randomly drawn by the Organizing Committee to establish the members of each Rink to ensure '*even competitiveness*'. **Extra curling brooms are needed, so please bring them along if you have them. We will also have a number of push sticks available for those of us who are not as agile as we used to be.**
